



GUIDE LINES FOR YOUNG TECHNOLOGIST AWARD



1. Age must be less than 35 years.
2. Should send scanned 10th marks card along with conference registration.
3. Research articles must be on sub – conference themes.
4. Must be original research article and not published anywhere else earlier.
5. Power point presentation **should not go beyond 12 slides** including maps & illustrations.
6. **Time:** 12 minutes presentation , 3 minutes discussion
7. **Dead line for abstract submission:** 09th October 2017
8. **Submission:** editor@ugit.net and drop a copy (CC) to geography@bub.ernet.in
9. Must submit the full length research paper before 28th Oct 2017.
10. The presentation must include the following sample format. (It can be adjustable)
 - Title, author's name, , etc (one slide)
 - Introduction (one slide)
 - Research Problem (one slide)
 - Objectives (one slide)
 - Methodology(one to two slide)
 - Analysis (Three to four slides)
 - Findings (Two to three slides)
 - Conclusion (one slide)
 - References must be in Harvard referencing system (one slide)
- 11 Should submit the PPT file of the Young Technologist Award well in advance
